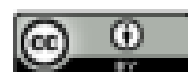

GOALS FOR OPEN ACCESS

**Making full and immediate
Open Access a reality**

By 2021, research funded by cOAlition-S funders must be published in open-access journals or platforms, or made immediately available in open access repositories without an embargo.

Goal for 2023: “In support of the Open Science transition, 100% Open Access publication and FAIR data is the new norm for researchers” ([Shaping 2030](#), p.22)



Government of the Netherlands

By 2024, 100% of publications from Dutch research universities should be published as open access

REPORTS: TOWARDS 100% OPEN ACCESS.

Immediately	Usually delayed: 0 – 48 months set by publisher accepted version 6 months Dutch Copyright Act published version
On website publisher and in repository UT	Usually only in repository UT
Re-use rights: CC licence	Usually without re-use rights (e.g., Taverne licence)
Plan-S compliant; only funded when DOAJ journal	Plan-S compliant; only when immediate with CC BY

REPORTS.

1. JOURNAL ARTICLES

- Support gold and diamond constructions, but libraries cannot fully finance the transition
- We need to strengthen the legal basis for green open access (immediate, with CC BY)
- Include open access in the system of recognition and rewards

2. ACADEMIC BOOKS AND BOOK CHAPTERS

- Transition of books will take long and cost a lot: spend more and lower the cost.
- Book chapters: Dutch Copyright Act.

REPORTS.

3. ALTERNATIVE OPEN-ACCESS PUBLICATION PLATFORMS

- Platforms based on F1000-research, overlay journals on preprint servers, and scholarly-led, diamond publishing initiatives
- Two-step publication process, other forms of peer review, a wide range of publishing options, and ownership of publishing by academic communities
- Alternative platforms can function as change agents for scientific publishing: innovative Open Science elements will be copied by mainstream publication channels and/or these platforms become important, established channels.
- Recognize peer-reviewed articles on these platforms, give structural financial support, and study the added value of an NWO/ZonMw platform

As a UT author, you can publish open access at a 100% discount in more than 10.000 high-quality journals, and easily open up your closed publications. This increases the visibility, downloads, citations, and impact of your publications. The University of Twente is in strong favour of open access to the results of its research. By 2023, publishing open access must be the norm for all UT authors.

AN EXTRA BOOST FOR OPEN ACCESS AT THE UT.

To make 100% open-access publishing the norm in 2023, all UT publications must be:

- Preferred route: published open access immediately*, or

* With a CC licence on publisher's website and UT Research Information, or only on UT Research Information

- Escape route: made openly available in UT Research Information after max 6 months**

** Opt-out procedure
